General committee in Värmland

Since 2004, the region and counties in Värmland have collaborated in a general committee, the assistive devices committee in Värmland. The committee decides which assistive devices can be prescribed regardless of where you live.

Rental of assistive devices in case of temporary disability/injury (adults)

If you need assistive devices for a shorter period, less than four months and the fitting does not require the expertise of a health and medical profession such as an occupational therapist or a physiotherapist, you can rent them. This applies to temporary disability/injury due to fractures, operations and other similar situations.

The assistive devices included are wheelchair, ramp for wheelchair, shower chair, toilet support, adjustable furniture riser, walking aid and walker within existing collection.

Rental cost:

100 SEK per assistive device per month started

The maximum amount is 200 SEK per month starting

Maximum amount 800 SEK for a 4-month period

Delivery and collection of assistive devices is primarily the responsibility of the user, the service can be provided by the assistive device company for a fee depending on time.

Delivery/collection/service costs 400 SEK. Delivery, collection and service are not included in the maximum amount.

Prices include VAT.

When the assistive devices are handed out there is an end date set (maximum 4 months) for the rental period. When returning the assistive devices, the current rental period will be billed.

Please note that:

The assistive devices should be handled and maintained according to the product's instruction manual.

The assistive devices must be cleaned before they are returned. You may be liable for compensation if assistive devices are lost, stolen or destroyed through careless handling.

Assistive devices that are not returned will be billed with a higher rental cost.

If you still need assistive devices after four months you will need to contact an occupational therapist or a physiotherapist who will assess whether an assistive device may be prescribed.
